Appellation:	Santa Rita Hills
Vineyards:	John Sebastiano Vineyard; 100 acres of Pinot Noir planted on 48 blocks on the eastern edge of the SRH appellation
Clone(s):	Block 19B(2.31 acres) Clone 2A/Block 25A(2.71 acres) Clone 667/Block 34(3.57 acres) Clone 115
Harvest:	September 30, 2010
Yields:	Clone 2A-1.34 tons per acre(71%)/Clone 115-0.24 tpa(19%)/Clone 667-0.16 tpa(10%)
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed into small open top fermenters
Innoculum:	Bourgogne RC 212 after a 4 day cold maceration
Fermentation:	12 day active, with punchdowns 2 times daily
Barrel Regime:	9 months in 2 nd & 3 rd fill French oak Burgundy barrels
Racking:	Without O2, once April 2011, then August 2011 prior to bottling
TA:	0.68 g/100ml
Alc:	15%
Ph:	3.98
Bottling:	August 8, 2011 without fining or filtration
Production:	250 cases
