The Mission Grape dates back to the 16<sup>th</sup> Century in California, when the Spanish padres brought cuttings along to plant around their missions. It is a pink/red thin skinned grape with large, loose clusters. The grapes for this "Port- styled" wine come from vines planted at the original Rancho Tepusquet in Northern Santa Barbara County during the 1950's. The fermentation was arrested with 170 proof grape brandy, leaving a residual sugar at 8.5% and 18% alcohol. This is a petite, delicate dessert wine to pair with summer red fruits and/or milk chocolate.

Winemaker's Notes:

A delicious, delicate dessert wine, light bodied(not clingy) and full of raspberry liqueur(framboise) and milk chocolate. This may even be a good summertime aperitif, poured over crushed ice. Also a great cigar wine.-Bill Wathen
