## 2018 Pinot Noir John Sebastiano Vineyard

Appellation:	Sta. Rita Hills
Vineyard:	John Sebastiano – Blocks 24, 25A & 26
Clones:	Swan, Dijon 667 & Entav 828
Harvest:	By hand between September 10 <sup>th</sup> and September 19 <sup>th</sup>
Yield:	About 3.5 tons per acre
Crush:	Swan clone – 25% whole cluster, 75% whole-berry destemmed in to a small, open-top fermenter; 667 clone – 10% whole cluster, 90% whole-berry destemmed in to a small, open-top fermenter; 828 clone – whole-berry destemmed in to a small, open-top fermenter
Inoculum:	3001 and RC212 after a 2-day cold maceration
Fermentation:	10-15 days active, with punch downs 2 times daily
Elevage:	16 months in 228L French Oak barrels, 38% new
Racking:	Once in April 2019, then again prior to bottling in March 2020
Bottling:	April 7, 2020 – without fining or filtration
Alcohol:	13.8%
pH:	3.66
TA:	0.548 g/100mL
Production:	624 cases
Retail:	\$56
