| Harvest:        | By hand on October 8 <sup>th</sup> & 9 <sup>th</sup>  |
| Yield:          | About 1.5 tons per acre   |
| Crush:          | 13% whole-cluster, 87% whole-berry destemmed in to small, open-top fermenters with<br>Viognier co-mingled |
| Inoculum:       | Rhone 2056 after a 2-day cold maceration  |
| Fermentation:   | 10 days active, with punch downs 2 times daily  |
| Elevage:        | 18 months in 500L French & Hungarian Oak puncheons, 33% new   |
| Racking:        | Once in April 2020, then again prior to bottling in June 2021   |
| Bottling:       | To be bottled mid-June 2021 - without fining or filtration  |
| Alcohol:        | 14.4%   |
