

2019 Cuvée Jeanne Marie Williamson-Doré Vineyard

Appellation: Los Olivos District

Vineyard/Blend: Williamson-Doré - 69% Grenache & 31% Mourvèdre

Clones: Grenache - Tablas; Mourvèdre - Tablas

Harvest: By hand: Grenache - October 18th; Mourvèdre - October 25th

Yield: About 3 tons per acre

Crush: Whole-berry destemmed in to small, open-top fermenters as individual varietal lots

Inoculum: GRE after a 3-day cold maceration

Fermentation: 10-14 days active, with punch downs 2 times daily

Elevage: 18 months in 228 French Oak barrels and 500 French & Hungarian Oak

puncheons, all neutral

Racking: Once in April 2020, then again prior to bottling in June 2021

Bottling: Bottled mid-June 2021 - without fining or filtration

Alcohol: 13.7%

pH: 3.45

TA: 0.558 g/100mL

Production: 375 cases
